Revenues of all listed companies (excluding the financial and insurance industries and MERCURIES & ASSOCIATES HOLDING, LTD.) in February 2026 rose by 13.94% compared to February 2025, and accumulated revenues rose by 22.45% compared to Year 2025

TWSE says that 1,035 listed companies (excluding 32 listed companies in the financial and insurance industries and MERCURIES & ASSOCIATES HOLDING, LTD.¹) have completed revenue filing by March 10, 2026.

According to TWSE, the summary shows that the listed companies as a whole reported NT\$3 trillion 642.2 billion in total revenue in February 2026, which was NT\$445.6 billion (13.94%) higher than the total revenue in February 2025. A total of 443 companies experienced revenue growth, while 592 companies had declines in revenue. The accumulated revenue of all listed companies from January to February was NT\$7 trillion 948.9 billion. The increase compared to year 2025 was NT\$1 trillion 457.1 billion (22.45%). A total of 573 companies experienced revenue growth, while 462 companies had declines in revenue.

Among all the listed companies, the main industries with a growing revenue tendency in February 2026 were "Computer and Peripheral Equipment," "Building Material and Construction," and "Tourism and Hospitality." The main industries with a declining revenue tendency were "Paper, Pulp," "Plastics" and "Electrical and Cable.

Among all the listed companies, the main industries with a growing tendency in their accumulated revenue from January to February were "Building Material and Construction," "Electronic Products Distribution" and "Computer and Peripheral Equipment." The main industry with a declining tendency were "Sports and Leisure," "Plastics" and "Oil, Gas and Electricity."
